Voluntary Interdistrict Choice Corporation Board Meeting Highlights • January 24, 2025

In actions at their January 26 meeting, the Board of Directors of the Voluntary Interdistrict Choice Corporation

- Approved minutes of the October 25, 2024 Board meeting.
- Approved contracted pupil transportation services bid from Missouri Central for the period August 1, 2025 through July 31, 2030.
- Approved the 2024/25 budget adjustments, resulting in revenues of \$30,749,907 (an increase of \$670,907) and revised expenditures of \$30,089,750 (a decrease of \$780,100). The projected reimbursement cap for county districts is \$7,500 per student (including Title 1 funds).
- Approved the adjustment of the cost of education reimbursement rate from \$7,000 to \$7,500 per student affective for the 2024/25 school year.
- Approved the appointment of the following to serve as the committee to recommend VICC salary increases at the April meeting for the 2025/26 school year:
 - Travis Bracht, VICC Board Chair, Affton School District Superintendent
 - Tim Dilg, VICC Vice-Chair, Valley Park School District Superintendent
 - John Brazeal, School District of Clayton
 - Kevin Carl, Hancock Place School District
 - Carrie Nunn, Parkway School District
 - Cyndee Byous, Rockwood School District
 - Paul Northington, VICC CEO
- Reviewed the summary of investments. As of December, 2024, the total for cash investments is 34,731,379.01.
- Reviewed a report on VICC's financial position. Through December, 2024, revenues totaled \$15,796,395.48. Expenditures for that period were \$9,767,437.26.
- Received the current enrollment numbers by district and grade. As of January 8, 2025, there were 1,932 city-to-county transfer students and 47 county-to-city transfer students.
